

Jesus Conquered Sin and Death to cal ALL into a New Identity




Repulsiveness of sin before a holy God (in relative units of disgustingness)

How Christians often categorize sin:



But... aren't certain sins an 'abomination' to the LORD?

- Found in <u>Proverbs</u>: Haughty eyes, the proud in heart, lying, shedding innocent blood, devising wicked plans, running toward evil, causing dissension, perverse people, cheating others, the wicked bringing sacrifices, condemning the just and justifying the wicked.
- □ Found in Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel: Offering incense and sacrifices with a wicked heart, idolatry, and adultery.
- Found in Leviticus and Deuteronomy: Offering sacrifices contrary to God's direction, practicing homosexuality, idolatry, sacrificing blemished animals, and bringing the wages of prostitution to pay for a vowed offering.

When we become Christians, do sinful desires stop?

Galatians 5:16-17 (ESV) ¹⁶ But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.

Though sinful desires continue, they are overcome by walking in the Spirit: regularly meditating on God's word, connecting with God through prayer (incl. asking for strength), as well as being in fellowship with other mature believers

When we give in to the flesh, we feed our sinful desires and we push ourselves away from God. When we ask for forgiveness and yield to the Holy Spirit, we grow

As you walk by the Spirit, do you recognize that your defenses will strengthen and your sinful desires will lessen? **1 Corinthians 6:9-11 (HCSB)** ⁹ Don't you know that the unrighteous will not inherit God's kingdom? Do not be deceived: No sexually immoral people, idolaters, adulterers, or anyone practicing homosexuality, ¹⁰ no thieves, greedy people, drunkards, verbally abusive people, or swindlers will inherit God's kingdom.
¹¹ And some of you used to be like this. But you were washed you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ

and by the Spirit of our God.

When looking at your sinful tendencies, do you say 'I was born that way'? Or...

Will you choose to be washed, sanctified, & justified by Jesus? Will you recognize your true identity can only be found in Him?
