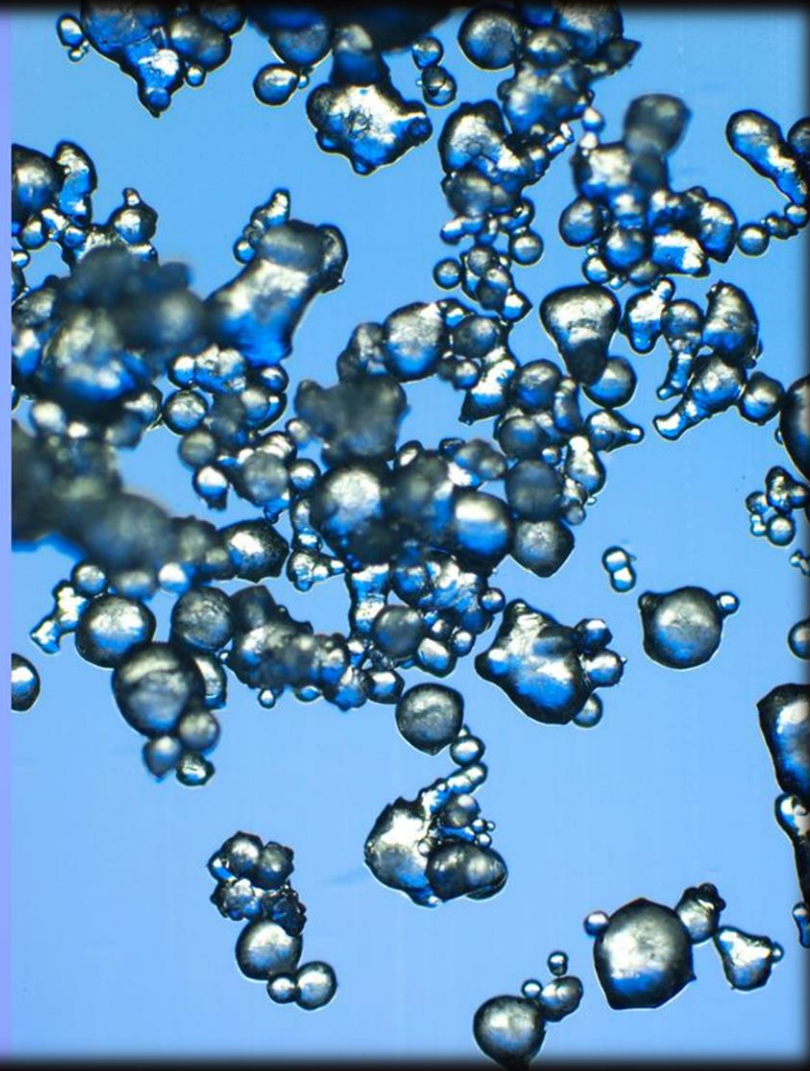
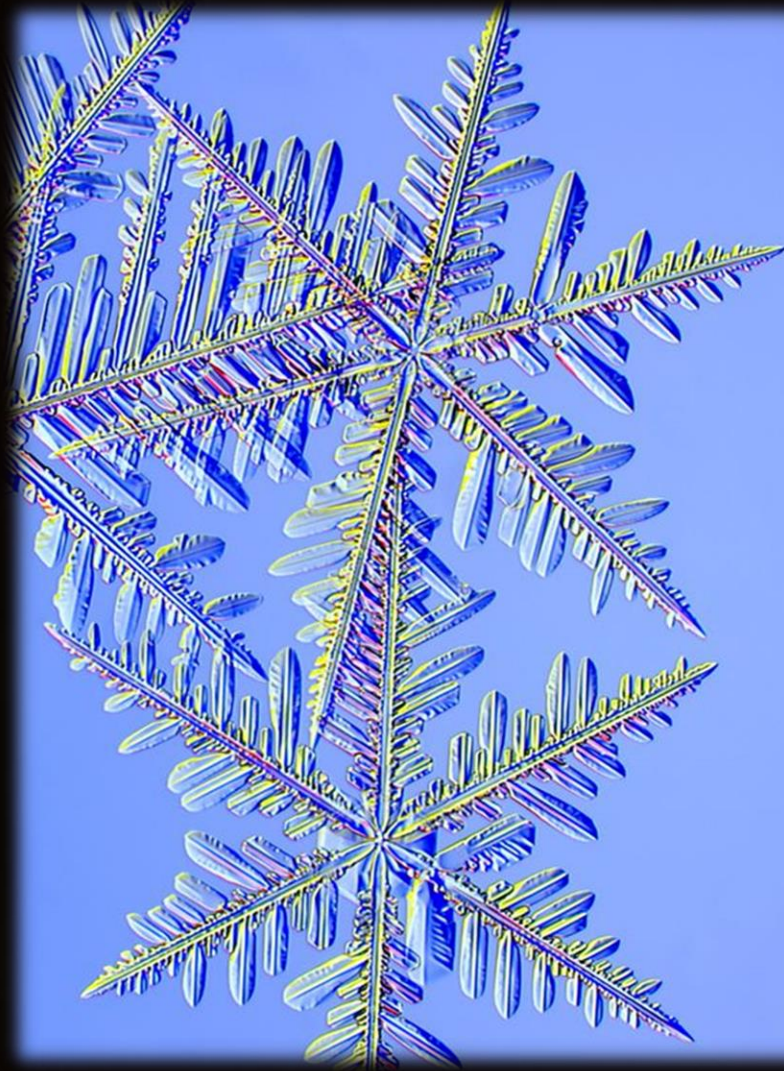

Genesis 1:1 (NASB) ¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Romans 1:19-20 (ESV) ¹⁹ For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. ²⁰ For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. **So they are without excuse.**

We need to start our relationship with God understanding that He's the creator of everything, including us.

The complexity of life leaves us with no excuse. We simply can't be an accident.

To accept that we're here by accident, is to ignore the common sense that God has given us.

Psalms 19:1-4 (HCSB) ¹ The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky proclaims the work of His hands. ² Day after day they pour out speech; night after night they communicate knowledge. ³ There is no speech; there are no words; their voice is not heard. ⁴ Their message has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens He has pitched a tent for the sun.

Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV2011) ⁸ For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast.

¹⁰ For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Colossians 1:15-17 (ESV) ¹⁵ He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. ¹⁶ For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. ¹⁷ And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together

What gifts has God created in you to serve the Kingdom?

1 Corinthians 6:20 (NKJV) For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

Acts 13 and Revelation 1 confirm that "firstborn" speaks of Jesus' preeminence and being firstborn from the dead.

When Jesus died on the cross, He paved the way for us to serve God through His Kingdom. We are to proclaim our creator/savior.

...It is not that the methods and institutions of science somehow compel us to accept a material explanation of the phenomenal world, but, on the contrary, that we are forced by our a priori adherence to material causes to create an apparatus of investigation and a set of concepts that produce material explanations, no matter how counter-intuitive, no matter how mystifying to the uninitiated. Moreover, that

materialism is absolute, for we cannot allow a Divine Foot in the door.”
