God is Complex and His Triune Nature is a Mystery

We use Imperfect Examples to Explain His Nature

- ❑ The shell, the white, and the yoke of an egg.
- ❑ Sand and water in a jar.
- ❑ Three leaf clover/ The sun, its rays and its heat, etc.
- ❑ Though it's not perfect, it's better that we look at how God reveals himself through His creation:
 - ✓ Humans, animals, plants, objects, and the entire universe have been created in three dimensions (height, width, and depth).
 - ✓ Time was created with 3 aspects: past, present, and future.
- ❑ *Hold on... does the Bible even contain the word "Trinity"?*

The Triune God Involved in Creation

Genesis 1:1 (NASB) In the beginning God created the heavens and

Psalms 95:6b,7b-8 (NKJV) ⁶ Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.

⁷ ...Today, if you will hear His voice: ⁸ "Do not harden your hearts, as in the rebellion. As *in* the day of trial in the wilderness."

Did you know the power of the resurrection gives us the Spirit?

Hebrews 3:7-9 (ESV) ⁷ Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says,

"Today, if you hear his voice, ⁸ do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness,"

John 16:7 (HCSB) Nevertheless, I am telling you the truth.

It is for your benefit that I go away, because if I don't go away the Counselor will not come to you. If I go, I will send Him to you.

John 20:22 (NLT2) ²² Then He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

***Modalism* won't fit since Jesus is subject to the Father**

1 Corinthians 15:25-28 (NIV2011) ²⁵ For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. ²⁶ The last enemy to be destroyed is death. ²⁷ For he "has put everything under his feet." Now

when it says that "everything" has been put under him, it is clear that this does not include God himself, who put everything under Christ.

²⁸ When he has done this, then the Son himself will be made subject to him who put everything under him, so that God may be all in all.

Jesus was given authority over all except for God the Father.

Once death has been destroyed, Jesus will hand the Kingdom to His Father since His role all along has been to give the glory to God the Father

God the Father gave Jesus the authority that He has.

Do you follow Jesus in a way that gives all the glory to God?

**Knowing God is triune won't save you. So, what's the point?
The point is that God's triune power brings salvation!**

John 3:16 (ESV) ¹⁶ "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

Ephesians 1:13 (HCSB) ¹³ When you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and when you believed in Him, you were also sealed with the promised Holy Spirit.
