# Our Awesome God is Faithful, True, and Abounds in Steadfast Love

- Scenario 4: You tell your boss that showing up 15 minutes late is not *really* late until it's been over a half hour.
- □ When it comes to God, your imagination and feelings have no bearing on His character. He is who He is.

# We should praise God for His steadfast character Do you really know that God's character does not change?

**Psalm 71:22 (NIV2011)** I will praise you with the harp for your faithfulness, my God; I will sing praise to you with the lyre, Holy One of Israel.

**Psalm 89:1-2 (NASB)** <sup>1</sup> I will sing of the lovingkindness of the LORD forever; To all generations I will make known Your faithfulness with my mouth. <sup>2</sup> For I have said, "Lovingkindness will be built up forever; In the heavens You will establish Your faithfulness."

**Lamentations 3:22-23 (ESV)** <sup>22</sup> The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; <sup>23</sup> they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

#### But what if we are unfaithful?

Have you confessed your sins so you can be forgiven?

2 Timothy 2:11-13 (ESV) 11 The saying is trustworthy, for: If we

have died with him, we will also live with him; <sup>12</sup> if we endure, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he also will deny us; <sup>13</sup> if we are faithless, he remains faithful— for he cannot deny himself.

Luke 22:31-32 (HCSB)<sup>31</sup> "Simon, Simon, look out! Satan has asked to sift you like wheat. <sup>32</sup> But I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail. And you, when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."

**1 John 1:9 (NASB)** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

### But... what is love? Agap

- **1 Corinthians 13:4-8a (NIV2011)** <sup>4</sup> Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup> It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup> Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.
- <sup>7</sup> It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.
- <sup>8</sup> Love <u>never fails</u>.

### So how can we effectively imitate God's character?

Do you abide in Jesus so that the Spirit can produce fruit in you? Step 1: Recognize Jesus as Lord and Savior and read God's word.

**John 14:6 (NKJV)** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

#### Step 2: Yield to the Power of the Holy Spirit.

**John 16:13a (HCSB)** <sup>13</sup> When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth.

**Galatians 5:16;22-23 (NASB)** <sup>16</sup> But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.
