2 Timothy 1:1-4 (ESV) ¹ Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God according to the promise of the life that is in Christ Jesus, ² To Timothy, my beloved child: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. ³ I thank God whom I serve, as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day. ⁴ As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy.

Notice Paul's affection for Timothy and how he stood in the gap when there was no mention of Timothy's father in his spiritual development.

Are you filled with joy when you are united with your brothers and sisters in Christ? Do you regularly pray on their behalf?

Who can you be lifting up in prayer to the Lord?
Can you tell a brother or sister in Christ that they bring you joy?

2 Timothy 1:5-8 (NIV2011) ⁵ I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also. ⁶ For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands. ⁷ For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline. ⁸ So do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner. Rather, join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God.

What a great legacy of motherly spiritual leadership... and to be memorialized in scripture!

Are you ashamed of the Gospel or do you consider it a privilege to even experience suffering for Him?

Be encouraged and encourage others to serve the lord with power, love, and self control

Are you building a spiritual legacy that will last generations?

2 Timothy 1:9-12 (HCSB) ⁹ He has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace, which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began.
