Does the resurrection really change lives?

Mary Magdalene – the first witness and proclaimer of the Gospel Paul – the greatest evangelist of Christianity who has impacted billions

Elisabeth Elliot – an evangelist who brought Jesus to the Auca tribe George Muller – a Christian who demonstrated love to thousands of orphans John 20:24-26 (ESV) ²⁴ Now Thomas, one of the Twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. ²⁵ So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe."²⁶ Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you."

John 20:27-31 (ESV) 27 Then he said to Thomas. "Put Do you have life in Jesus' name? When you see Jesus face to face, do you want His words to be "Well done good and faithful servant" or "I never knew you"? ²⁹ Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and vet have believed." ³⁰ Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹ but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
