James 4:1-3 (HCSB) ¹ What is the source of wars and fights among you? Don't they come from the cravings that are at war within you? You desire and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and war. You do not have because you do not ask. ³ You ask and don't receive because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your evil desires. 1 Peter 3:7 (NKJV) Husbands, likewise, dwell with *them* with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as *being* heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

Men, in general, are created with more physical strength and this is not to be used to lord over, oppress, or harm women, especially your wife. Rather, we are to love them as Christ loves the church and gave His life for his bride.

Married men, have you even considered this? When you're not honoring your wife and not dwelling with her with understanding, you are putting a massive roadblock in front of your prayers.

Married couples, do you know your covenant relationship is designed to bring glory to God's Kingdom?

Psalm 66:16-20 (ESV)¹⁶ Come and hear, all you who fear God, and I will tell what he has done for my soul. ¹⁷ I cried to him with my mouth, and high praise was on my tongue. ¹⁸ If I had cherished iniquity in my heart, the Lord would not have listened. ¹⁹ But truly God has listened; he has attended to the voice of my prayer. ²⁰ Blessed be God, because he has not rejected my prayer or removed his steadfast love from me!
